This Privacy Policy is published in compliance with inter alia:

- Section 43A of the Information Technology Act, 2000;
- Rule 4 of the Information Technology (Reasonable Security Practices and Procedures and Sensitive Personal Data or Information) Rules, 2011; and
- Rule 3(1) of the Information Technology (Intermediaries Guidelines) Rules, 2011.

This Privacy Policy deals with information we collect in relation to our Platform and explains what information we collect, how we collect and use it, how you can access/update it, and how we protect it.

1. General

1.2 The collection and processing of information in the course of our delivery of Services, or other contractual engagements, will be done in accordance with the specific terms applicable thereto, and not by this Privacy Policy.

1.3 By accessing or using Our Platform or by otherwise giving Us Your information, You confirm that You have the capacity to enter into a legally binding contract and have read, understood, and agreed to the practices and policies outlined in this Privacy Policy.

1.4 You hereby consent to Our collection, use, sharing, and disclosure of Your information as described in this Privacy Policy.

1.5 We may modify, add, or delete from this Privacy Policy from time to time. Your continued access to, or use of the Platform, will be deemed an acceptance of the said changes.

2. Information Collected and Method of Collection



2.1 We collect the following types of information about You: User Information, Demographic Information, Behavioural Information, and Indirect Information.

2.2 User Information: In order to access Our Platform, You may be required to provide Us with information such as Your name, email address, mobile number, the company/organization You work for, title, designation, and physical addresses. We may also collect User Information when You visit Our offices (e.g., for meetings, seminars), which may include dietary or accessibility requirements that imply health information.

2.3 Demographic Information: We may collect information which is not unique to You, such as age, gender, and current location details.

2.4 Behavioural Information: We may collect information about how You use the Platform, including usage statistics, traffic data, IP address, browser type, operating system, and access times.

2.5 Indirect Information: Your use of certain third-party services on the Platform requires Us to collect such information as is considered necessary for that purpose.



2.6 Sensitive Personal Data or Information (SPDI): The SPDI Rules define SPDI to include passwords, financial information, health conditions, sexual orientation, medical records, and biometric information. We understand that all Personal Information provided by You is voluntary. By using the Platform, You consent to Our collection and use of such information in accordance with this Policy.

3. Use of Information

3.1 We use Your Information for purposes including:

- Operating and improving the Platform and Our business.
- Analyzing data, tracking trends, and conducting research.
- Conducting audits and quality assessments.
- Internal operational purposes such as record keeping and compliance with taxation laws.
- Providing You with regulatory updates or inviting You to seminars/webinars We believe are relevant to You.
- Complying with applicable law and investigating illegal activities or fraud.
- Responding to Your queries and gathering feedback.



4. Disclosure of Information

4.1 We may disclose Your Information to third parties in the following manner:

- To companies and individuals acting as counterparties, consultants, and advisors.
- To third-party service providers authorized to perform functions on Our behalf (e.g., IT companies, data centers).
- If legally required to do so pursuant to an order from a governmental entity or in good faith to conform to legal requirements, protect Our rights, or prevent a crime.

The Platform may contain links to third-party websites. We have no control over such Third Party Services and are not responsible for any collection or disclosure of Your information by them.

6. Changes to Your Information

6.1 You may review, correct, update, or change Your Personal Information by emailing Us at contact@stambhlegal.in

We will comply within a reasonable time unless required to keep it for legal purposes or for our records.

7. Security of Your Information

We endeavour to maintain physical, technical, and procedural safeguards to protect Your Information against loss, misuse, damage, or unauthorized access. This includes reviewing Our security measures and restricting access to Personal Information to employees and agents who need to know it.

8. Retention of Information

8.1 We will destroy or anonymize Your Personal Information within 5 (five) years of it being reasonable to assume that the purpose for collection is no longer served or retention is no longer necessary.
